



PARENTS' CODE OF ETHICS GIRLS' BASKETBALL

The purpose of this document is to ensure that parents of youth participants in the Trinity Plus Foundation/Carolina Lynx Basketball Program are made aware of and are participants who "Lead by Example". This document embodies the leadership that the Trinity Plus Foundation/Carolina Lynx Basketball Program expects from all parents. Each parent responsible for a child participating in the TPF must sign this code of ethics. Failure to observe and adhere to these policies may result in dismissal of your child from the TPF.

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement to the team participating in the Trinity Plus Foundation/Carolina Lynx Basketball Program by following this code of ethics:

I, as the parent, must always consider the personal safety of the athletes.

I shall respect game officials and support the coaches of the organization.

I shall not indulge in conduct, which will incite the players or spectators against the officials. Public criticism of the officials or players is unethical.

I shall respect my opponents, display gracious behavior during competition and require my child/player to conduct themselves in a similar fashion.

I shall actively use my influence to enhance sportsmanship by my parents and spectators.

I shall take an active role in the prevention of drug, alcohol, and tobacco use by my players.

I will recognize the importance of the athlete's academic development and support the Carolina Lynx Annual NCAA Educational Session.

NCAA and National AAU rules and regulations require that if a parent is asked to leave a gymnasium and/or sports arena during a competitive event, then the parent's child/player is required to leave also.
